





## FILL YOUR TOOL BOX WITH STUFF






#### **MOUSE** in the HOUSE

Take a brown lunch sack and cut a hole in the bottom flat part of the sack. Decorate the outside of the house with markers. Reinforce the bottom with a piece of art foam if desired.

Take a piece of brown wrapping paper or another lunch sack and fold the piece of the brown paper in half.

Place the mouse pattern on the fold and cut it out. Glue, tape or staple the curved edge of the mouse leaving the straight side open.

This mouse is a puppet and it lives in the sack. This mouse house can be folded and placed in your storytelling TOOL BOX.





## FOLD- A-TALKING SHAPE PUPPET






#### LARGE CONSTRUCTION PAPER for ADULT PUPPET

Large art foam – Same color as construction paper Permanent markers for features or use same shape for eyes, nose

Glue – Small shapes glued on large shape Scissors

# Circle Triangle Square Rectangle Oval Diamond Octagon Trapezoid Heart Star





#### **DIRECTIONS:**

Cut each shape using the patterns – place on art foam and cut out - Cut the smaller shapes to make the face features glue the face features on the larger shape
